Fire Marshall Course Overview

Under The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 it is a requirement that all public buildings undertake a fire risk assessment to identify the hazards associated with fire safety and put into place certain control measures in an attempt to counteract these hazards.

It is also a requirement under this legislation that all organisations appoint sufficient Fire Marshall's to cover the day to day responsibilities for fire safety. These individuals should be given sufficient training and information so that they can for fill their role effectively and to give them the information on their legal responsibilities in this role.

Our aim at Good Skills Training is that all delegates should enjoy their Fire Marshall Course and that by the end of their course all delegates should be confidently aware of their legal duties with regard to fire safety and be aware of what to do in the event of a fire in their organisation.
