First Aid Instructor Course Duration

21 Guided Learning Hours.

Usually delivered over 3 days, 9:00 - 17:00

First Aid Instructor Course Prerequisite

Learners must have a current HSE First Aid at Work Qualification. Learners must also hold a current valid teacher or trainer qualification (such as the PTLLS).

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First Aid Instructor Course Assessment Process

This course is assessed by 3 practical assessments and 1 written assessment.

First Aid Instructor Course Renewal Process

First Aid Instructors are required to keep their qualification valid by undertaking a 2 day First Aid and Instructor Requalification Course every 3 years.

Are There Any Fees Once I Have Qualified As a First Aid Instructor?

First Aid Instructors are required to undergo annual monitoring assessments to ensure that they are still achieving a high standard of delivery and that they are following HSE requirements for first aid delivery. This is a HSE requirement and is charged at £125 + VAT plus expenses.
