
















Highfield Level 2 Award in Food Safety in Course (Catering/Manufacturing/Retail)

The Level 2 Award in Food Safety Course is a one-day course designed for those who work in a food handling capacity. Food safety legislation requires that all food handlers receive appropriate training in food hygiene, in line with their work activities so they can handle food safely. The level 2 in food safety covers topics that are regarded by the Food Standards Agency as important for maintaining good practice.


Who is the Highfield Level 2 Award in Food Safety Course for?

-  Staff who work with food, or want to work with food
-  Anyone with an interest in basic food hygiene
-  People undertaking this qualification must be 14 years of age, or above

What is in the Highfield Level 2 Award in Health Food Safety Course syllabus?

-  An introduction to food safety
-  Microbiological hazards
-  Contamination hazards and controls
-  Food Poisoning and its control
-  Personal hygiene
-  Design of premises and equipment
-  Cleaning and disinfection
-  Food pests and control
-  Food safety management from purchase to service
-  Food safety law and enforcement


How long does it take to complete the Highfield Level 2 Award in Food Safety Course?

-  This course is normally completed in one day

What will be included in my Highfield Level 2 Award in Food Safety Course?

-  Training to national standards
-  Manual for each learner
-  Exam fees
-  Certificates on successfully completing the course and assessments for each person

How is the Highfield Level 2 Award in Food Safety Course Assessed?

-  Multiple choice examination:
 - 45 minutes
 - 20 questions
 - Pass mark is 60%



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How is the Highfield Level 2 Award in Food Safety Course certificated, or Accredited?

-  This course is an OFQUAL accredited qualification through Highfield Qualifications
-  Qualification Number **603/2033/3**
-  On successfully completing the assessment all learners receive an A4 certificate from Highfield Qualifications

How do I renew my Highfield Level 2 Award in Food Safety Course?

-  There is no formal expiry on the Level 2 Award in Food Safety
-  Like other health and safety topics, there is a requirement that staff are kept up to date with any changes in legislation or best practice and undergo CPD
-  Learners can undertake the ½ day Level 2 in Food Safety Refresher Course. Best practice is to sit this every 3-years
